People with mental retardation in the U.S., currently estimated to number between 6.2 and 7.5 million, have historically been victimized both by their ...MECP2 duplication syndrome is an X-linked neurodevelopmental disorder characterized by severe to profound mental retardation, infantile hypotonia, mild dysmorphic features, poor speech development, autistic features, seizures, progressive spasticity, and recurrent infections. Claes et al. (2000) described a kindred in which 4 males in 2 generations in an X-linked recessive pedigree pattern had severe mental retardation, slowly progressive spastic paraplegia, facial hypotonia, and maxillary hypoplasia.
